Physician Type	Regular Visits	Urgent Referrals
Primary Care (PCP)	No prior authorization is required for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assigned PCP; or Affiliated group physician 	<p>Urgent referrals are only to be submitted if the normal time frame for authorization will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be detrimental to the patient's life or health; or Jeopardize patient's ability to regain maximum function; or Result in loss of life, limb or other major bodily function <p>(All referrals not meeting urgent criteria will be downgraded to a routine referral request and follow routine turn-around times.)</p>
Specialty Care (SCP)	<p>All initial requests for specialty consults require a prior authorization from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assigned PCP; or Contracted SCP <p>The initial prior authorization will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> One specialty consult; plus As many routine follow-ups as necessary (excluding office code 99215, which requires a new prior authorization) 	

No Prior Authorization is Required For:

- Emergency services
- Urgent Care visits
- Sensitive services (which include family planning)
- Sexually transmitted disease services
- Abortion
- Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) testing
- Basic prenatal care services
- Routine obstetric services
- Minor consent services
- Primary and preventive care services
